



## Albrey Ralph Todd

April 22, 1944 - March 20, 2020

Albrey “Ralph” Todd, 75, of Hawk Point, Missouri, passed away on Friday, March 20, 2020 at SSM St. Joseph Hospital West in Lake Saint Louis, Missouri. Ralph was born on April 22, 1944 in Washington, Missouri, a son of the late Albrey Leonard and Erma Grace (Cunningham) Todd. He was united in marriage to Carol Lancshe on September 18, 1965 at the Hawk Point Community Church in Hawk Point, Missouri and to this union one son and one daughter were born.

Ralph graduated from the Troy Buchanan High School in 1962. He continued with the family business in the Auto Body Repair, he started at the age of 13 helping his dad at Todd’s Auto Sales.
