Arlie H. Wegener, 95, of Troy, Missouri, passed away on October 31, 2021. He was born on October 21, 1926 in rural Lincoln County to Herman and Matilda (Meine) Wegener. He served in the Merchant Marines during WWII on both the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans.

On June 26, 1947 he married Betty LaRue, his wife of 62 years. She preceded him in death in 2009. They farmed together in Troy for over 50 years. Arlie served as a board member of Boatman's Bank and Lincoln County Farmer's Mutual Insurance.
