January 7, 1956 - September 14, 2022

Arthur Samuel Jenkin, 66, of Moscow Mills, Missouri, passed away on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 in Hawk Point, Missouri. He was born on January 7, 1956 in East Orange, New Jersey and the son of the late Arthur Stephen and Philomenia Ann (O'Reilly) Jenkin. He was united in marriage to Colleen Mary Brennan at the Queen of Universe Church in Pennsylvania and to this union two sons and one daughter were born.

Arthur was a committed husband, father, grandfather, and friend. A fierce defender of the people and causes he cared for, he also bore a gentle spirit which shone through in the kindness he extended to animals and to those in need. Strong-willed by nature, Arthur was also curious and willing to listen and learn from others and the world around him. His character is best reflected in a statement he once made, commenting on a painting of an Eastern Bluebird: "The bluebird, while seemingly content, is constantly inquisitive. Always seeking, watching, and learning. Although his regimen is strict, he always has time for kindness. He shares this kindness with all he encounters."

Let us remember Arthur for his big heart and let us heed his call to extend kindness and understanding out into the world. Arthur will be missed, but he will remain a part of all those whose lives he impacted for the better.

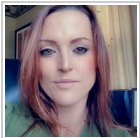

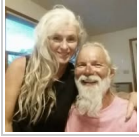

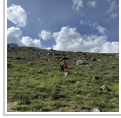
