Carol "Zip" Stanley Underwood, 84 of Hawk Point, Missouri, went home to the Lord on Saturday, November 29, 2025 at his residence in Hawk Point, Missouri. He was born on October 2, 1941, in Bland, Missouri, and was the son of the late Stanley S. Underwood and Violet M. (Branson) Underwood. Zip was united in marriage to Brenda K. Allen in 1963 at the El Toro Marine Base and she preceded him in death on September 30, 2006.

Zip served his country in the United States Marines from August 24, 1959 and was honorably discharged on September 12, 1965. Zip and Brenda owned and operated Knight Hawk Supply, where they sold and distributed hydraulic supplies throughout the world. He was very active with the Missouri Patriot Guard and the Marine Corps League. Zip was a regular at the Lincoln County Veterans Talk. He had a passion for serving his community and looked forward to assisting with the Marine Corps Toys for Tots. Zip was a car enthusiast; he owned several restored cars over the years and would participate in local car shows. He was a member of various car clubs. Zip would organize Poker Runs, traveling to various towns and restaurants. He had a love for shooting guns on his range at his house. Zip was a friendly, social butterfly, who wanted to help others. His outgoing personality will be missed.

Zip is survived by his one sister, Cynthia Doria of Glendale, MO; cousins and

his friends that became family. He is preceded in death by his parents, Stanley S. Underwood and Violet M. Doria and wife, Brenda K. Underwood.
