Charles "Charlie" Theodore Mershon, 60, of Moscow Mills, Missouri, passed away on Monday, February 22, 2016 surrounded by his family at his residence. He was born on May 13, 1955 in Troy, MO a son of the late John Robert and Blanche Elizabeth (Callaway) Mershon. Charlie met the love of his life Merry Livingston 25 years ago and they have shared many wonderful years together.

Charlie attended the Troy Buchanan High School, he entered the U.S. Army on September 15, 1972 in St. Louis, MO. While serving his country he earned a National Defense Service Medal, a Marksman M16 and was honorably discharged on September 5, 1975. He worked as a Mechanic in Troy for over 40 years and was recently employed by Greg's Automotive. Charlie still continued to work even after he was diagnosed with cancer. As Charlie was a truly dedicated employee the owners of Greg's, Kelly and Shawn Evans, continued to support Charlie and his family through his illness. Not only did they hold a fundraiser but they provided medical insurance coverage when he was no longer able to work. Charlie enjoyed tinkering on cars, attending car shows, dirt track races and racing RC cars. He loved listening to music and spending time with his family, especially on the 4th of July.
