Clearthur White, Jr., 67, of Moscow Mills, Missouri, went home to the Lord on Friday, June 30, 2023, surrounded by his family in Moscow Mills, Missouri. He was born on June 10, 1956, in Troy, Missouri, and was the son of the late Clearthur White and Mary J. Green. Clearthur was united in marriage to Chewona Barnum on July 19, 1975, in Chicago, Illinois and together they share eight children.

Clearthur graduated in 1974 from Harper High School in Chicago. He proudly served his country as a Sergeant in the United States Army from 1976 until he was honorably discharged in 1984. Clearthur retired after 12 years of dedication as a mailman with the United States Postal Services and later went to work with Kelly Services at Reckitt Benckiser. Growing up, he was a member of the Pleasant Valley Missionary Baptist Church and most recently, an active member of the Journey Church in Troy. His hobbies included fishing, bowling, DJing and singing. He had the best sense of humor and knew how to deliver tough love when needed. 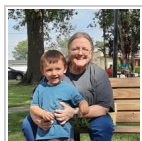
