Daniel A. Burleson, 67, of Troy, Missouri, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 15, 2019 at SSM Health St. Joseph Hospital in St. Charles, Missouri. 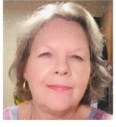
