Elizabeth Jean "Betty" Teasley Turnbull, 83, of Troy, Missouri, passed away at SSM St. Joseph Hospital West in Lake St. Louis, surrounded by her family on Saturday, April 22, 2017. She was born on May 5, 1933 in Lincoln County, Missouri, a daughter of the late Callie and Thelma "Darline" (Jefferson) Teasley. Betty was united in marriage to Eldon Turnbull on August 26, 1965 at the St. Stephens United Methodist Church in Troy, he preceded her in death on November 9, 2002.
