Elton Jackson Harris, Sr., 88, of Louisiana, Missouri, passed away on Tuesday, December 6, 2022 in Louisiana, Missouri. He was born on April 6, 1934 in Chickasaw County, Mississippi and the son of the late Lonnie and Bessie (Bergermeir). He was united in marriage to Lois Jane Mosley on December 6, 1973 at the Gila River Indian Reservation.

Elton graduated high school and continued his education as a plumber. He served the Lord by becoming an ordained preacher through the Bible Way Association. Elton founded the Bible Faith Ministry.
