February 1, 1926 - January 19, 2023

Ernest "Hop" Woolfolk, 96, of Troy, Missouri, passed away on Thursday, January 19, 2023 in Troy, Missouri. He was born on February 1, 1926, in Troy, Missouri, and was the son of Ernest S. Woolfolk, Sr. and Saloma (Duello) Woolfolk. He was united in marriage to Barbara Jean Taylor on May 21, 1949 in Troy, Missouri and she preceded him in death on March 20, 1991.

Hop attended Keelstone School House in Moscow Mills, MO and graduated from Buchanan High in 1944. He served his country in the United States Navy from 1944 until he was honorably discharged in 1946. Hop retired from Cuivre River Electric Cooperative as a Warehouseman with 43 years of dedication. He was a member of the Troy Elks Lodge #2805 and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 2. Hop enjoyed attending Lincoln County Veterans Coffee Talk.
