Frank William Kadlec, 79 of Troy, Missouri, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family on Sunday, November 27, 2016 at Lincoln County Nursing and Rehab in Troy, Missouri. He was born on February 24, 1937 in Vandalia, IL and was the son of Frank A. and Adelia (Martinek) Kadlec. Frank was united in marriage to Janet Evenson and she preceded him in death.
