Lorraine Lucie Duff, 83, of Hawk Point, Missouri, passed away on Tuesday, April 14, 2020 at SSM St. Joseph Hospital West in Lake Saint Louis, Missouri. 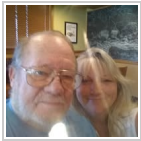

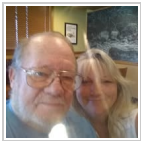
