Marian L. Richardson (Mato), age 88, was born on December 15, 1928 and was called home quietly and peacefully on Thursday, March 9, 2017 at the Kansas City Hospice House in Kansas City, Missouri.

Marian was preceded in death by her parents Joseph and Lelia P. Shelton, her son LeRoy (Ricky) Richardson, Jr, two sisters: Clara Higgins, Minnie Shelton, and four brothers: Joseph, Bill, Tom and Edward "Jack" Shelton.

As Marian's health failed, her grandchildren: Ricky and Angel, served as her primary caregivers. Marian later moved to Kansas City with her daughter, who became her primary caregiver.

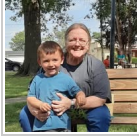
