Marleen Meta Waechter, 83, of Troy, Missouri, passed away on Saturday, January 1, 2022 in Troy, Missouri. She was born on November 1, 1938 in St. Charles, Missouri, a daughter of the late Otto and Lena (Neimeyer) Berlekamp. She was united in marriage to Elroy “Roy” S. Waechter on September 27, 1958 at the Frieden’s United Church of Christ in St. Charles, Missouri and to this union three sons and one daughter were born. Roy preceded her in death on August 7, 2017.

Marleen attended Blackjack Grade School and graduated from Francis Howell High School in 1956 where she was Valedictorian. In her earlier years she worked for McDonnell Douglas and as a Paralegal. Marleen maintained her Real Estate and Insurance Broker License for over 50 years. Roy and Marleen owned and operated various businesses over the years, bicycle shop, a grocery store, a restaurant, a gas station, a jewelry store, a junk yard and in the construction field. They founded the first plumbing store in Troy known as Troy Plumbing Supply in 1979. After several years of hard work and dedication the business was moved down the street to where they founded Ro-Mar Supply, which is still actively run by the family. Marleen was always working and keeping the family businesses in order. She loved spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren.

Marleen is survived by two sons: Shawn Waechter and wife Mandy of Troy, MO and Daniel "Danny" Waechter of Troy, MO; four grandchildren: Otto, Danny, Jr., Kaylie Lynn and Taylon and one sister, Margie Furlong of St. Charles, MO and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Roy Waechter, one daughter, Tammy Lynn Waechter and one infant son.
