Michael Troy Herman, 48, of Troy, Missouri, passed away on Thursday December 8, 2016 in Troy, Missouri. He was born on June 25, 1968 in Trinidad, West Indies and was the son of the late Michael P. and Laine (Pickens) Herman.

Troy graduated from St. Charles High School in 1986 and following his graduation he served his Country in the United States Army during Desert Storm. 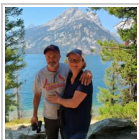

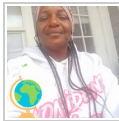
