Michael graduated from Pattonville High School and continued his education at Florissant Valley Community College. 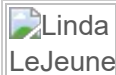

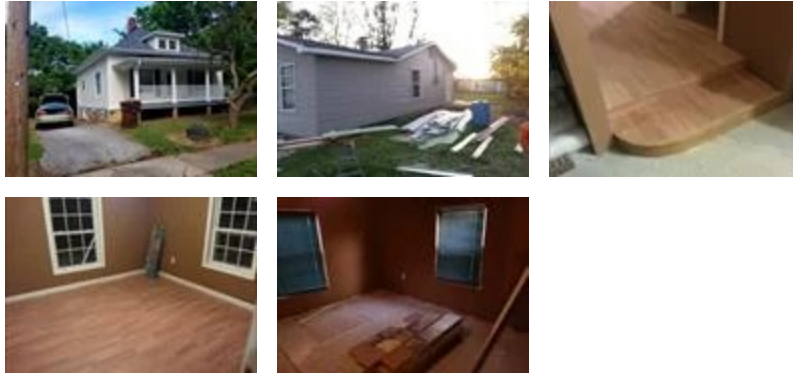

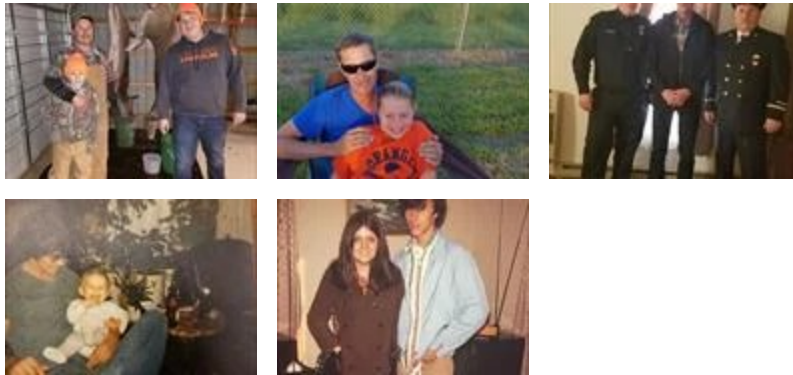
