Mildred “Darline” Leek, 84, of Hawk Point passed away on Monday, July 7, 2014 at St. Joseph Hospital West in Lake Saint Louis, Missouri. She was born February 18, 1930 in Corso, Missouri; a daughter of Thomas J. and Alma (Mitchell) Lockett. Darline was married on March 11, 1950 to Monty H. Leek, who preceded her in death on January 26, 2007.
