Peggy Jane Wickell-Turner-Voss, 77, of Bowling Green, Missouri, passed away on Friday, December 10, 2021 in Troy, Missouri. She was born on December 28, 1943, in Edgewood, Missouri, a daughter of the late Earl and Helen (Henderson) Wickell.

Peggy lived in Edgewood, MO until 1953, when they moved to Cyrene, Missouri. She accepted her lord and Savior at a revival preached by brother Harold Anderson at the age of 6, at Cyrene Baptist Church in 1949. She had been a member off and on all her life. Peggy attended grade school at Cyrene and Eagle Point School. In May 1961 she graduated from Bowling Green High School. Peggy was known for baking the best pies and cakes. She liked to read and work on puzzles. Peggy valued the memories she made with her family.
