Roy Morse, 73, passed from life at his residence in Edina, Missouri August, 8, 2019 with his loving wife Patricia of Edina at his side. He was born on December 9, 1945 in Moscow Mills, Missouri a son of Dewey Alvin and Edna Lee (Twellman) Morse. Roy was united in marriage with the love of his life, Patricia, on May 3, 1969 at Frieden's United Church of Christ in Moscow Mills, Missouri. To this union 4 children were born.

Roy attended elementary school in Moscow Mills and graduated from Troy Buchanan High School. Roy developed an interest in farming at an early age and was actively engaged in that occupation prior to graduating from high school. Following graduation, he attended Tech School in Kansas city for one year and then returned to Lincoln County. He purchased his first farm in 1969. Roy enjoyed attending auctions and often went home with a lot of "treasures". Playing cards, especially pinochle was a favorite activity along with hunting and reading non-fiction books about war and history. His favorite meal was popcorn and homemade ice cream. Roy was a lifetime member of the National Rifle Association, a 10-year member of the Arbor Day Celebration, a Century 4-H family member and a member of the Republican National Committee.
