Sybil Maxine Creech, 91, of Troy, passed away on Monday, June 16, 2014 at Lincoln County Nursing and Rehab in Troy, Missouri. She was born on July 27, 1922 in Olney, Missouri, a daughter of the late Joseph and Mazie (Ward) Stotler. Sybil was united in marriage to Henry “Jack” Clay Creech on March 15, 1942, in Olney, Missouri and he preceded her in death on January 31, 1993. 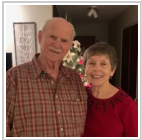
